The Ogliastran sea is guaranteed to amaze. The long beaches in the south and the small creeks in the north are the pearls of the Mediterranean. The rocks that emerge from the clear blue appear to be suspended between sea and sky, offering a safe harbour for gulls and seabirds. Centuries of isolation have protected it from building developments and overcrowding. This is a natural environment that has remained mostly intact through the minimal interference of mankind, having managed to extract great pleasure from its secrets without harming it.

Far removed from the hectic life of the city, in Ogliastro the pleasure of admiring and being awestruck by the stunning views, intense colours, and intoxicating scents is there to be rediscovered.

This is where patches of total tranquillity can be found, interrupted only by the sounds of nature; unique harmonies composed by the whistle of the wind on the branches, the sea against the shore.

Nature reigns supreme, often manifesting itself in breathtaking scenery. Among the bastions of tacchi and tonneri, at the heart of the woodland emerges the mysterious presence of Perda Liana, a splendid rocky tower and paradise for mouflons.

Under the eagles' flight, winding gorges open out that descend from the mountains, passing through lakes and waterfalls. An outback so charming and full of pathos, where even the rocks seem to come alive and play with our imagination, creating natural arches that are as perfect as frames, and stones with formations that remind us of animals and human faces. Even the pebbles join in on the fun, dancing beneath our feet along the Supramonte paths. The Ogliastran rocks have watched the world go by since days long forgotten, since magical eras when fairies made their tiny homes here: the mysterious Domus de Janas.

Here the abundance of space and the generosity of the climate and mankind have allowed nature to shine in a way that it can in very few other places in the world.

The sea, sky, and land all compete for domination in this fascinating and rugged biodiversity. From the dark depths of the ocean to the snow-covered mountaintops of Gennargentu, life in Ogliastra is one of perfect harmony in any season: here you can spot the trajectories of Eleonora's falcons or the furrows of wild boars, observe mouflon catching their prey, or enjoy the sight of fox cubs playing.

The fish, although silent, also fascinate for their wonderful shapes and sizes, in waters so picturesque that they could only be the brushstroke of an artist.

Between the schist and the granite, the limestone and the basalt, mountain roses blossom and peonies bloom. The vegetation is a series of colourful miracles embedded alongside gentians on the slopes of Mount Gennargentu. Many species of wild orchids bring the countryside to life, watched over by yews - relics of the ice ages - and junipers, the wise custodians of a hundred-year-old memory.
